

"Days of Awe" Life Inventory Assessment

Renew your Covenant with God today by taking Inventory of your Life, especially during this season of the "Days of Awe" (*the 10-days of Repentance between the Feast of Trumpets and the Feast of Atonement*) and "Atonement" (*the day of God's sealing in the Book of Life, and God's ultimate Judgement of the Origin of the Sin of all mankind*), to learn if the Curses that you are currently challenged with fall under God's Correction and Re-alignment from "Not Obeying" God's Voice and "Not Carefully doing all His Commandments and His Statutes". This is the season of "**Crowning God as our King**" and God choosing you and I as His people, identified by who we will choose to Listen to and Obey, as whoever we choose to listen and obey to, we are slave of (Romans 6:16-18). Following is God's Life Inventory Assessment Scripture Evaluation:

Deuteronomy 29-31

Deuteronomy 29

The Covenant Renewed in Moab

¹ These are the words of the covenant that the LORD commanded Moses to make with the people of Israel in the land of Moab, besides the covenant that he had made with them at Horeb.

² And Moses summoned all Israel and said to them . . . ⁹ Therefore keep the words of this covenant and do them, that you may prosper in all that you do . . .

. . . ¹³ that he may establish you today as his people, and that he may be your God, as he promised you, and as he swore to your fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob. ¹⁴ It is not with you alone that I am making this sworn covenant, ¹⁵ but with whoever is standing here with us today before the LORD our God, and with whoever is not here with us today.

¹⁶ "You know how we lived in the land of Egypt, and how we came through the midst of the nations through which you passed. ¹⁷ And you have seen their detestable things, their idols of wood and stone, of silver and gold, which were among them. ¹⁸ Beware lest there be among you a man or woman or clan or tribe whose heart is turning away today from the LORD our God to go and serve the gods of those nations. Beware lest there be among you a root bearing poisonous and bitter fruit, ¹⁹ one who, when he hears the words of this sworn covenant, blesses himself in his heart, saying, 'I shall be safe, though I walk in the stubbornness of my heart.' This will lead to the sweeping away of moist and dry alike. ²⁰ The LORD will not be willing to forgive him, but rather the anger of the LORD and his jealousy will smoke against that man, and the curses written in this book will settle upon him, and the LORD will blot out his name from under heaven. ²¹ And the LORD will single him out from all the tribes of Israel for calamity, in accordance with all the curses of the covenant written in this Book of the Law. ²² And the next generation, your children who rise up after you, and the foreigner who comes from a far land, will say, when they see the afflictions of that land and the sicknesses with which the LORD has made it sick ²³ the whole land burned out with brimstone and salt, nothing sown and nothing growing, where no plant can sprout, an overthrow like that of Sodom and Gomorrah, Admah, and Zeboiim, which the LORD overthrew in his anger and wrath ²⁴ all the nations will say, 'Why has the LORD done thus to this land? What caused the heat of this great anger?' ²⁵ Then people will say, 'It is because they abandoned the covenant of the LORD, the God of their fathers, which he made with them when he brought them out of the land of Egypt, ²⁶ and went and served other gods and worshiped them, gods whom they had not known and whom he had not allotted to them. ²⁷ Therefore the anger of the LORD was kindled against this land, bringing upon it all the curses written in this book, ²⁸ and the LORD uprooted them from their land in anger and fury and great wrath, and cast them into another land, as they are this day.'

²⁹ "The secret things belong to the LORD our God, but the things that are revealed belong to us and to our children forever, that we may do all the words of this law.

Deuteronomy 30

Repentance and Forgiveness

¹ "And when all these things come upon you, the blessing and the curse, which I have set before you, and you call them to mind among all the nations where the LORD your God has driven you, ² and return to the LORD your God, you and your children, and obey his voice in all that I command you today, with all your heart and with all your soul, ³ then the LORD your God will restore your fortunes and have mercy on you, and he will gather you again from all the peoples where the LORD your God has scattered you . . .

It is here that **I challenge every Follower of God to take Inventory of their Lives**, anytime, but especially during this season of the “*Days of Awe*” (*the 10-days of Repentance between the Feast of Trumpets and the Feast of Atonement*) and “*Atonement*” (*the day of God’s sealing in the Book of Life, and God’s ultimate Judgement of the Origin of the Sin of all mankind*), when all of our Brothers and Sisters that are Jews are themselves taking Inventory, to learn if the Curses that they are currently challenged with fall under God’s Correction and Re-alignment from “Not Obeying” God’s Voice and “Not Carefully doing all His Commandments and His Statutes”, but rather through Repentance (*simply defined as “stop doing it our way and start doing it God’s way”*), returning back to God’s **Designed Blessings** that “Overtakes” those who “Do Obey” God’s Voice and “Do Carefully do all His Commandments and His Statutes”. With that, read through each one of God’s Curses, and if any of them relate to your own lives, ask God these two questions:

1. Lord, in what area of my life am I not listening to or obeying You in your teaching and instruction, the entire Word of God, that is bringing this curse upon me?
- and Secondly,*
2. Lord, now that you have revealed to me these “secret things” in my heart, I take full responsibility for the curse, through Repentance, and now ask for your help in learning to do the words in your Law that teach me how to do it your way, through your teaching and instruction?

Now it is time to take Inventory, to learn if the Curses that you are currently challenged with fall under God’s Correction and Re-alignment, then asking and applying the above two questions towards God’s promised Restoration for those who obey His voice in all that He has commanded you through His Word, to restore your fortunes and have mercy on you . . .

Deuteronomy 28

Blessings for Obedience

¹ “And if you faithfully obey the voice of the LORD your God, being careful to do all his commandments that I command you today, the LORD your God will set you high above all the nations of the earth. ² And all these blessings shall come upon you and overtake you, if you obey the voice of the LORD your God . . .

Curses for Disobedience

¹⁵ “But if you will not obey the voice of the LORD your God or be careful to do all his commandments and his statutes that I command you today, then all these curses shall come upon you and overtake you . . .

- ¹⁶ Cursed shall you be in the city, and
- ¹⁶ cursed shall you be in the field.
- ¹⁷ Cursed shall be your basket and your kneading bowl.
- ¹⁸ Cursed shall be the fruit of your womb and the fruit of your ground. . . .
- ¹⁹ Cursed shall you be when you come in, and cursed shall you be when you go out.
- ²⁰ **“The LORD will send on you curses, confusion, and frustration in all that you undertake to do, until you are destroyed and perish quickly on account of the evil of your deeds, because you have forsaken me.”**
- ²¹ **“The LORD will make** the pestilence stick to you until he has consumed you off the land that you are entering to take possession of it.
- ²² **“The LORD will strike you with wasting disease and with fever, inflammation and fiery heat, and with drought and with blight and with mildew. They shall pursue you until you perish.” . . .**
- ²⁵ **“The LORD will cause you** to be defeated before your enemies. You shall go out one way against them and flee seven ways before them. And you shall be a horror to all the kingdoms of the earth.
- ²⁷ **“The LORD will strike you** with the boils of Egypt, and with tumors and scabs and itch, of which you cannot be healed.

- ²⁸ ***The LORD will strike you*** with madness and blindness and confusion of mind, ²⁹ and you shall grope at noonday, as the blind grope in darkness, and you shall not prosper in your ways. And you shall be only oppressed and robbed continually, and there shall be no one to help you.
- ³⁰ . . . You shall build a house, but you shall not dwell in it. You shall plant a vineyard, but you shall not enjoy its fruit . . .
- ³² Your sons and your daughters shall be given to another people, while your eyes look on and fail with longing for them all day long, but you shall be helpless. ³³ A nation that you have not known shall eat up the fruit of your ground and of all your labors, and
- ³² . . . ***you shall be only oppressed and crushed continually,*** ³⁴ so that you are driven mad by the sights that your eyes see.
- ³⁵ ***The LORD will strike you*** on the knees and on the legs with grievous boils of which you cannot be healed, from the sole of your foot to the crown of your head.
- ³⁶ ***"The LORD will bring you (to) . . . serve other gods of wood and stone.***
- ³⁷ And you shall become a horror, a proverb, and a byword among all the peoples where the LORD will lead you away . . .
- ⁴¹ You shall father sons and daughters, but they shall not be yours, for they shall go into captivity . . .
- ⁴³ The sojourner who is among you shall rise higher and higher above you, and you shall come down lower and lower. ⁴⁴ He shall lend to you, and you shall not lend to him. He shall be the head, and you shall be the tail.
- ⁴⁵ ***All these curses shall come upon you and pursue you and overtake you till you are destroyed,*** because you did not obey the voice of the LORD your God, to keep his commandments and his statutes that he commanded you. ⁴⁶ They shall be a sign and a wonder against you and your offspring forever. ⁴⁷ Because you did not serve the LORD your God with joyfulness and gladness of heart, because of the abundance of all things, ⁴⁸ therefore you shall serve your enemies whom the LORD will send against you, in hunger and thirst, in nakedness, and lacking everything. And he will put a yoke of iron on your neck until he has destroyed you. . . .
- ⁵⁸ ***If you are not careful to do all the words of this law that are written in this book, that you may fear this glorious and awesome name, the LORD your God,*** ⁵⁹ ***then the LORD will bring on you and your offspring extraordinary afflictions, afflictions severe and lasting, and sicknesses grievous and lasting.***
- ⁶⁰ ***And he will bring upon you again*** all the diseases of Egypt, of which you were afraid, and they shall cling to you. ⁶¹ Every sickness also and every affliction that is not recorded in the book of this law, the LORD will bring upon you, until you are destroyed.
- ⁶² Whereas you were as numerous as the stars of heaven, you shall be left few in number, because you did not obey the voice of the LORD your God. ⁶³ ***And as the LORD took delight in doing you good and multiplying you, so the LORD will take delight in bringing ruin upon you and destroying you. And you shall be plucked off the land that you are entering to take possession of it.***
- ⁶⁴ "And the LORD will scatter you among all peoples, from one end of the earth to the other, and there you shall serve other gods of wood and stone, which neither you nor your fathers have known. ⁶⁵ And among these nations you shall find no respite, and there shall be no resting place for the sole of your foot, but the LORD will give you there a trembling heart and failing eyes and a languishing soul. ⁶⁶ Your life shall hang in doubt before you. Night and day you shall be in dread and have no assurance of your life. ⁶⁷ In the morning you shall say, 'If only it were evening!' and at evening you shall say, 'If only it were morning!' because of the dread that your heart shall feel, and the sights that your eyes shall see. ⁶⁸ And the LORD will bring you back in ships to Egypt, a journey that I promised that you should never make again; and

there you shall offer yourselves for sale to your enemies as male and female slaves, but there will be no buyer."

Deuteronomy 30

Repentance and Forgiveness

...⁴If your outcasts are in the uttermost parts of heaven, from there the LORD your God will gather you, and from there he will take you. ⁵And the LORD your God will bring you into the land that your fathers possessed, that you may possess it. And he will make you more prosperous and numerous than your fathers. **⁶And the LORD your God will circumcise your heart and the heart of your offspring, so that you will love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul, that you may live.** ⁷And the LORD your God will put all these curses on your foes and enemies who persecuted you. ⁸And you shall again obey the voice of the LORD and keep all his commandments that I command you today. ⁹The LORD your God will make you abundantly prosperous in all the work of your hand, in the fruit of your womb and in the fruit of your cattle and in the fruit of your ground. For the LORD will again take delight in prospering you, as he took delight in your fathers, **¹⁰when you obey the voice of the LORD your God, to keep his commandments and his statutes that are written in this Book of the Law, when you turn to the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul.**

The Choice of Life and Death

¹¹For this commandment that I command you today is not too hard for you, neither is it far off. ¹²It is not in heaven, that you should say, 'Who will ascend to heaven for us and bring it to us, that we may hear it and do it?' ¹³Neither is it beyond the sea, that you should say, 'Who will go over the sea for us and bring it to us, that we may hear it and do it?' **¹⁴But the word is very near you. It is in your mouth and in your heart, so that you can do it.**

¹⁵See, I have set before you today life and good, death and evil. ¹⁶If you obey the commandments of the LORD your God that I command you today, by loving the LORD your God, by walking in his ways, and by keeping his commandments and his statutes and his rules, then you shall live and multiply, and the LORD your God will bless you in the land that you are entering to take possession of it. ¹⁷But if your heart turns away, and you will not hear, but are drawn away to worship other gods and serve them, ¹⁸I declare to you today, that you shall surely perish. You shall not live long in the land that you are going over the Jordan to enter and possess. **¹⁹I call heaven and earth to witness against you today** (with this witness being given, God has told us that until the establishment of a "New Heaven and New Earth" His Word will never pass away and is still relevant today), **that I have set before you life and death, blessing and curse.** Therefore choose life, that you and your offspring may live, ²⁰loving the LORD your God, obeying his voice and holding fast to him, for he is your life and length of days, that you may dwell in the land that the LORD swore to your fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, to give them."

Deuteronomy 31

Joshua to Succeed Moses

1 So Moses continued to speak these words to all Israel . . . **³The LORD your God himself will go over before you. He will destroy these nations before you, so that you shall dispossess them, and Joshua will go over at your head, as the LORD has spoken.** ⁴And the LORD will do to them as he did to Sihon and Og, the kings of the Amorites, and to their land, when he destroyed them. ⁵And the LORD will give them over to you, and you shall do to them according to the whole commandment that I have commanded you. **⁶Be strong and courageous. Do not fear or be in dread of them, for it is the LORD your God who goes with you. He will not leave you or forsake you.**

Here we see the parallel of the Promised Successor of Moses, "I will put my words in his mouth, and he shall speak to them all that I command him." Deuteronomy 18:18

"He will not leave you or forsake you. "Go into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation.

All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. **Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I commanded you;** and **lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age.** He who has believed and has been baptized shall be saved; but he who has disbelieved shall be condemned."

Matthew 28:18-20, Mark 16:15-20, Luke 24:44-53 and Acts 1:3-11

⁷ Then Moses summoned Joshua and said to him in the sight of all Israel, "Be strong and courageous, for you shall go with this people into the land that the LORD has sworn to their fathers to give them, and you shall put them in possession of it." ⁸ It is the LORD who goes before you. He will be with you; he will not leave you or forsake you. Do not fear or be dismayed" . . .

The prophecy of the Future Messiah, Joshua or "Salvation", who will one day take all of those who Follow Him into the Ultimate Promise Land, "Heaven", Victoriously:

Deuteronomy 18

A New Prophet like Moses

¹⁵ "The LORD your God will raise up for you a prophet like me from among you, from your brothers – it is to him you shall listen – ¹⁶ just as you desired of the LORD your God at Horeb on the day of the assembly, when you said, 'Let me not hear again the voice of the LORD my God or see this great fire any more, lest I die.' ¹⁷ And the LORD said to me, 'They are right in what they have spoken. ¹⁸ I will raise up for them a prophet like you from among their brothers. And I will put my words in his mouth, and he shall speak to them all that I command him. ¹⁹ And whoever will not listen to my words that he shall speak in my name, I myself will require it of him. ²⁰ But the prophet who presumes to speak a word in my name that I have not commanded him to speak, or ²¹ who speaks in the name of other gods, that same prophet shall die.' ²¹ And if you say in your heart, 'How may we know the word that the LORD has not spoken?' – ²² when a prophet speaks in the name of the LORD, if the word does not come to pass or come true, that is a word that the LORD has not spoken; the prophet has spoken it presumptuously. You need not be afraid of him.

Deuteronomy 31

The Reading of the Law

. . . ⁹ Then Moses wrote this law and gave it to the priests, the sons of Levi, who carried the ark of the covenant of the LORD, and to all the elders of Israel. ¹⁰ And Moses commanded them, "At the end of every seven years, at the set time in the year of release, at the Feast of Booths, ¹¹ when all Israel comes to appear before the LORD your God at the place that he will choose, you shall read this law before all Israel in their hearing. ¹² Assemble the people, men, women, and little ones, and the sojourner within your towns, that they may hear and learn to fear the LORD your God, and be careful to do all the words of this law, ¹³ and that their children, who have not known it, may hear and learn to fear the LORD your God, as long as you live in the land that you are going over the Jordan to possess."

Joshua Commissioned to Lead Israel

¹⁴ And the LORD said to Moses, "Behold, the days approach when you must die. Call Joshua and present yourselves in the tent of meeting, that I may commission him." And Moses and Joshua went and presented themselves in the tent of meeting. ¹⁵ And the LORD appeared in the tent in a pillar of cloud. And the pillar of cloud stood over the entrance of the tent.

¹⁶ And the LORD said to Moses, "Behold, you are about to lie down with your fathers. Then this people will rise and whor after the foreign gods among them in the land that they are entering, and they will forsake me and break my covenant that I have made with them. ¹⁷ Then my anger will be kindled against them in that day, and I will forsake them and hide my face from them, and they will be devoured. And many evils and troubles will come upon them, so that they will say in that day, 'Have not these evils come upon us because our God is not among us?' ¹⁸ And I will surely hide my face in that day because of all the evil that they have done, because they have turned to other gods . . .

. . . ²³ And the LORD commissioned Joshua the son of Nun and said, "Be strong and courageous, for you shall bring the people of Israel into the land that I swore to give them. I will be with you."

²⁴ When Moses had finished writing the words of this law in a book to the very end, ²⁵ Moses commanded the Levites who carried the ark of the covenant of the LORD, ²⁶ "Take this Book of the Law and put it by the side of the ark of the covenant of the LORD your God, that it may be there for a witness against you. ²⁷ For I know how rebellious and stubborn you are. Behold, even today while I am yet alive with you, you have been rebellious

against the LORD. How much more after my death! ²⁸ Assemble to me all the elders of your tribes and your officers, that I may speak these words in their ears and call heaven and earth to witness against them. ²⁹ **For I know that after my death you will surely act corruptly and turn aside from the way that I have commanded you. And in the days to come evil will befall you, because you will do what is evil in the sight of the LORD, provoking him to anger through the work of your hands.** (this prophecy is the proof that Joshua is not the Promised Prophet of Deuteronomy 18, but a future Prophet that is the one true Messiah, Savior and Redeemer of all things, during this prophesied future "Jubilee", day of restoration of all things)

God's Designed Blessings that "Overtakes" those who "Do Obey" God's Voice and "Do Carefully do all His Commandments and His Statutes":

Deuteronomy 28

Blessings for Obedience

¹"And if you faithfully obey the voice of the LORD your God, being careful to do all his commandments that I command you today, the LORD your God will set you high above all the nations of the earth. ² And all these blessings shall come upon you and overtake you, if you obey the voice of the LORD your God:

- **³Blessed shall you be in the city, and blessed shall you be in the field.**
- **⁴Blessed shall be the fruit of your womb and the fruit of your ground and the fruit of your cattle, the increase of your herds and the young of your flock.**
- **⁵Blessed shall be your basket and your kneading bowl.**
- **⁶Blessed shall you be when you come in, and blessed shall you be when you go out.**
- **⁷"The LORD will cause your enemies who rise against you to be defeated before you. They shall come out against you one way and flee before you seven ways.**
- **⁸The LORD will command the blessing on you in your barns and in all that you undertake.**
- **⁹And he will bless you in the land that the LORD your God is giving you.**
- **⁹**The LORD will establish you as a people holy to himself, as he has sworn to you, if you keep the commandments of the LORD your God and walk in his ways.****
- **¹⁰And all the peoples of the earth shall see that you are called by the name of the LORD, and they shall be afraid of you.**
- **¹¹And the LORD will make you abound in prosperity, in the fruit of your womb and in the fruit of your livestock and in the fruit of your ground, within the land that the LORD swore to your fathers to give you.**
- **¹²The LORD will open to you his good treasury, the heavens, to give the rain to your land in its season and to bless all the work of your hands. And you shall lend to many nations, but you shall not borrow.**
- **¹³And the LORD will make you the head and not the tail, and you shall only go up and not down, if you obey the commandments of the LORD your God, which I command you today, being careful to do them,**
- **¹⁴and if you do not turn aside from any of the words that I command you today, to the right hand or to the left, to go after other gods to serve them.**
