Shadows

Freedom from Human Rules

"Let no one therefore judge you in eating or in drinking, or in respect of a festival or a new moon or Sabbaths which are a shadow of what is to come but the Body of the Messiah."

Colossians 2:16-17 (KJV)

Here, he is telling us that the **Appointed Times** (Feast Days) and the Sabbath are a <u>shadow of things to come</u>. A shadow is of the same image as what it is portraying. So, doesn't this imply these will be observed in the future kingdom? And note the text says that these commands **ARE** a <u>shadow of things to come</u>, **not** "were a shadow" or "used to be a shadow" of things to come. He then says, "let no man judge you" (in these things: new moon; Sabbath; feasts) 'but the Body of Messiah.' The word "is" has been added to the original text and did not appear in the Greek.

The <u>Body of Messiah</u> is to judge each other with regard to these things. A second witness to this can be found in the following verses:

"But now I have written to you not to keep company with anyone called 'a brother,' if he is one who whores, or greedy of gain, or an idolater, or a reviler, or a drunkard, or a swindler – not even to eat with such a one. For what have I to do with judging outsiders? Do you not judge, to pick out by separating, to be of opinion, to judge those who are inside? But Elohim judges those who are outside. And put away the wicked one from among you!" 1 Corinthians 5:11-13

"not judge" - (krínō (2919): to distinguish (to approve what is correct and reject what is wrong - discern).

"to pick out": choose.

"opinion": decide.

"to judge": "bringing to trail" - expressing severe disapproval of (someone or something), typically in a formal statement).

Let's Remember what God told the People to do before they got delivered out of Egypt, which we are reminded to do prior to Christ's 2^{nd} Coming:

1. I Will Provide the Way Out and All the Way Into the Promise Land

Exodus 11:2 - Speak now in the hearing of the people, that they ask, every man of his neighbor and every woman of her neighbor, for silver and gold jewelry."

2. Know the Times

Exodus 12:1-17 - The Lord said to Moses and Aaron in the land of Egypt, "**This month shall be for you the beginning of months. It shall be the first month of the year for you.** ³ Tell all the congregation of Israel that on the tenth day of this month every man shall take a lamb according to their fathers' houses, a lamb for a household.

- \dots "Then they shall take some of the blood and put it on the two doorposts and the lintel of the houses in which they eat it \dots
- ... ¹³ The blood shall be a sign for you, on the houses where you are. And when I see the blood, I will pass over you, and no plague will befall you to destroy you, when I strike the land of Egypt.
- ¹⁴ "This day shall be for you a memorial day, and you shall keep it as a feast to the Lord; throughout your generations, as a statute forever, you shall keep it as a feast . . .
- ... ¹⁷ And you shall observe the Feast of Unleavened Bread, for on this very day I brought your hosts out of the land of Egypt. Therefore you shall observe this day, throughout your generations, as a statute forever."

A Passage of Scripture that Stood Out to Me this Week, in a profound way:

Next Week's Big Day - "The Birth of the Redemption & Salvation of Mankind":

"The King is in the Field"

Last Saturday began the new month of Elul (which this year falls between Sat, Aug 7th to Mon, Sept 6th - 2021)

These 40 days are a time of meeting with the King of Kings – a time or Repentance and joy. Which also corresponds to the prophesied Messianic Virgin Birth (Isaiah 7:14), <u>Jesus' Birth</u> (which this year would fall on **Friday, August 20**th to Saturday, August 21st – 2021), and the prophesied Messianic Return (Zechariah 14:1-4, 9), <u>Jesus' Future Return</u> (which this year will fall between Mon, Sept 6th to Wed, Sept 8th – 2021).

Forty weeks (the period of human gestation) after Jesus' conception, following the Holy Spirit's impregnating the Virgin Mary, on Kislev 25, 3755, the first night of Hanukkah, December 6, 6 BCE, Jesus is born. It is Friday night, Elul 9, in the Jewish year 3756. This corresponds to our Gregorian calendar date of September 9, 5 BCE. It is the beginning of the weekly Sabbath. The Jewish people have a particular name for every Sabbath and they read specific passages of Scripture on those Sabbaths. The one on which Jesus is born is called KiTeitzei, "When you go out", Deuteronomy 21:10 - 25:19:

"When you go out to war against your enemies, and the Lord your God gives them into your hand and you take them captive . . ." Deut 21:10

Revelation 13

The First Beast

13 And I saw a beast rising out of the sea, with ten horns and seven heads, with ten diadems on its horns and blasphemous names on its heads. ² And the beast that I saw was like a leopard; its feet were like a bear's, and its mouth was like a lion's mouth. And to it the dragon gave his power and his throne and great authority. ³ One of its heads seemed to have a mortal wound, but its mortal wound was healed, and the whole earth marveled as they followed the beast. ⁴ And they worshiped the dragon, for he had given his authority to the beast, and they worshiped the beast, saying, "Who is like the beast, and who can fight against it?"

⁵ And the beast was given a mouth uttering haughty and blasphemous words, and it was allowed to exercise authority for forty-two months. ⁶ It opened its mouth to utter blasphemies against God, blaspheming his name and his dwelling, ^[a] that is, those who dwell in heaven. ⁷ Also it was allowed to make war on the saints and to conquer them. ^[b] And authority was given it over every tribe and people and language and nation, ⁸ and all who dwell on earth will worship it, everyone whose name has not been written before the foundation of the world in the book of life of the Lamb who was slain. ⁹ If anyone has an ear, let him hear:

¹⁰ If anyone is to be taken captive,

to captivity he goes;

if anyone is to be slain with the sword,

with the sword must he be slain.

Here is a call for the endurance and faith of the saints.

The Second Beas

¹¹ Then I saw another beast rising out of the earth. It had two horns like a lamb and it spoke like a dragon. ¹² It exercises all the authority of the first beast in its presence, ^[s] and makes the earth and its inhabitants worship the first beast, whose mortal wound was healed. ¹³ It performs great signs, even making fire come down from heaven to earth in front of people, ¹⁴ and by the signs that it is allowed to work in the presence of ^[d] the beast it deceives those who dwell on earth, telling them to make an image for the beast that was wounded by the sword and yet lived. ¹⁵ And it was allowed to give breath to the image of the beast, so that the image of the beast might even speak and might cause those who would not worship the image of the beast to be slain. ¹⁶ Also it causes all, both small and great, both rich and poor, both free and slave, ^[e] to be marked on the right hand or the forehead, ¹⁷ so that no one can buy or sell unless he has the mark, that is, the name of the beast or the number of its name. ¹⁸ This calls for wisdom: let the one who has understanding calculate the number of the beast, for it is the number of a man, and his number is 666.^[II]

Week 44 - SHOFTIM (Judges)

Deuteronomy 16:18-21:9; Isaiah 51:12-52:12; Mark 14:53-64

"Appoint judges **shoftim**] and officials [**shotrim**] for each of your tribes in every town the Lord your God is giving you, and they shall judge [**shafat**] the people fairly [**tzedek mishpat** / righteous judgment]."

Deuteronomy 16:18

Last week, in *Reading "See / Behold"* (Re'eh), "*Reclaiming the Blessing*", God set a blessing and a curse before the Israelites. The blessing was a result of obeying God's commandments and the curse a result of forsaking them.

Deuteronomy 11:26-32

²⁶ "See, I am setting before vou today a blessing and a curse: ²⁷ the blessing, if you obey the commandments of the Lord your God, which I command you today, ²⁸ and the curse, if you do not obey the commandments of the Lord your God, but turn aside from the way that I am commanding you today, to go after other gods that you have not known. ²⁹ And when the Lord your God brings you into the land that you are entering to take possession of it, you shall set the blessing on Mount Gerizim and the curse on Mount Ebal. ³¹ For you are to cross over the Jordan to go in to take possession of the land that the Lord your God is giving you. And when you possess it and live in it, ³² you shall be careful to do all the statutes and the rules that I am setting before you today.

In this week's Scripture Reading (*Torah portion*), Moses instructed the nation of Israel in the appointing of judges (called **shoftim** in Hebrew) and law enforcement officers (called **shotrim**) to administer justice. These judges and officers would not only teach but also interpret the laws of the Torah.

1. What is the difference between a judge and an officer? A judge refers to one qualified to deliver judgments according to the laws of the Torah. The officer then enforces these legal judgments, even by force if necessary.

The Hebrew prophet Isaiah promised that there would come a day when judges would be restored as in the days of old: "I shall restore your judges [shoftim] as at first, and your counselors [yaats] as at the beginning." Isaiah 1:26

Although Isaiah mentions the judges, the officers do not appear in this prophecy, but rather "counselors."

Why will counselors replace the role of officers?

In the days of redemption, when the Messiah returns to rule and reign in righteousness, there will be no need for "enforcers" of the Torah.

In the Messianic era, all will have such a deep desire to follow and obey the Lord that only counselors will be needed to explain and clarify (not to enforce) the decisions of the judges.

Even today (before that great day of the Lord that is to come) those who are truly in Messiah do not need external coercion to keep God's commandments and judgments.

For when we have been **given** a <u>new heart</u> and a <u>new spirit</u>, there arises within us a **desire** to keep God's laws and commandments, not in a spirit of legalism, but out of a heart of love:

"I will put My Spirit within you and cause you to walk in My statutes, and you will be careful to observe My ordinances." Ezekiel 36:27

For those who believe in Jesus but do not observe His commandments in the Torah, the question we need to ask is:

"Why not?"

Either the person is **not truly following Jesus** and filled with His Holy Spirit, *or* they have **received and accepted a teaching** of false grace which erroneously emphasizes freedom from guilt over freedom from sin.

Certainly, Jesus did not pay the ultimate price to set us free from bondage to sin so that we can continue sinning without guilt.

"Everyone who sins breaks the law; in fact, sin is lawlessness." 1 John 3:4

"⁴ Whoever says "I know him" but does not keep his commandments is a liar, and the truth is not in him, ⁵ but whoever keeps his word, in him truly the love of God is perfected. By this we may know that we are in him: ⁶ whoever says he abides in him ought to walk in the same way in which he walked." 1 John 2:4-6

2. Trusting in God for Victory

Moses tells the people to not be afraid of the inhabitants of the Promised Land while in battle; Adonai will be with them.

Before battle, the Cohanim (Priests) were to encourage the troops to trust in God.

"When you are about to go into battle, the priest shall come forward and address the army. He shall say: 'Hear, Israel: Today you are going into battle against your enemies. Do not be fainthearted or afraid; do not panic or be terrified by them. For the LORD your God is the one who goes with you to fight for you against your enemies to give you victory." **Deuteronomy 20:2–4**

3. Deuteronomy 18:9-14 9 "When you come into the land that the Lord your God is giving you, you shall not learn to follow the abominable practices of those nations. 10 There shall not be found among you anyone who burns his son or his daughter as an offering, anyone who practices divination or tells fortunes or interprets omens, or a sorcerer 11 or a charmer or a medium or a necromancer or one who inquires of the dead, 12 for whoever does these things is an abomination to the Lord. And because of these abominations the Lord your God is driving them out before you. 13 You shall be blameless before the Lord your God, 14 for these nations, which you are about to dispossess, listen to fortune-tellers and to diviners. But as for you, the Lord your God has not allowed you to do this.

Why were such harsh penalties in place for worshiping false gods?

Although in our day, there exists a great emphasis on human rights and free choice, God's law is concerned with preserving purity and Godliness.

By purging evil from the nation, holiness was protected

"The hands of the witnesses must be the first in putting that person to death, and then the hands of all the people. You must purge the evil from among you." (Deuteronomy 17:7)

The Occul

All forms of occult practices also carried the death penalty.

These included many spiritual practices that are commonplace today and for the most part widely accepted: sorcery, divination, fortune telling, astrology, wizardry, and listening to psychics, mediums or those who act as a channel for spirits of the dead.

God acknowledges that pagans participate in the occult, but these practices are part of what leads to the downfall of nations and they are forbidden for any of God's people.

Receiving guidance from one's astrological chart, reading palms or tea leaves, attending séances, or even using Ouiji boards are not permitted for people of God; nevertheless, many today (either in ignorance or defiance of the law) read books about wizards and dabble in the occult.

This is a dangerous spiritual path.

"The nations you will dispossess listen to those who practice sorcery or divination. But as for you, the LORD your God has not permitted you to do so." **Deuteronomy 18:14**

4. Deuteronomy 17:1-7 "You shall not sacrifice to the Lord your God an ox or a sheep in which is a **blemish**, any defect whatever, for that is an abomination to the Lord your God. – **Bring Only Your Best!**

² "If there is found among you, within any of your towns that the Lord your God is giving you, a man or woman who does what is evil in the sight of the Lord your God, in transgressing his covenant, ³ and has gone and served other gods and worshiped them, or the sun or the moon or any of the host of heaven, which I have forbidden, ⁴ and it is told you and you hear of it, then you shall inquire diligently, and if it is true and certain that such an abomination has been done in Israel, ⁵ then you shall bring out to your gates that man or woman who has done this evil thing, and you shall stone that man or woman to death with stones. ⁶ On the evidence of two witnesses or of three witnesses the one who is to die shall be put to death; a person shall not be put to death on the evidence of one witness. ⁷ The hand of the witnesses shall be first against him to put him to death, and afterward the hand of all the people. So you shall purge the evil from your midst.

5. Deuteronomy 17:14 Laws Concerning Israel's Kings

¹⁴ "When you come to the land that the Lord your God is giving you, and you possess it and dwell in it and then say, 'I will set a king over me, like all the nations that are around me,' ¹⁵ you may indeed set a king over you whom the Lord your God will choose. One from among your brothers you shall set as king over you. You may not put a foreigner over you, who is not your brother. ¹⁶ Only he must not acquire many horses for himself or cause the people to return to Egypt in order to acquire many horses, since the Lord has said to you, 'You shall never return that way again.' ¹⁷ And he shall not acquire many wives for himself, lest his heart turn away, nor shall he acquire for himself excessive silver and gold.

¹⁸ "And when he sits on the throne of his kingdom, he shall write for himself in a book a copy of this law, approved by the Levitical priests. ¹⁹ And it shall be with him, and he shall read in it all the days of his life, that he may learn to fear the Lord his God by keeping all the words of this law and these statutes, and doing them, ²⁰ that his heart may not be lifted up above his brothers, and that he may not turn aside from the commandment, either to the right hand or to the left, so that he may continue long in his kingdom, he and his children, in Israel.

6. Deuteronomy 18:9-14 A New Prophet like Moses – ¹⁵ "The Lord your God will raise up for you a prophet like me from among you, from your brothers – it is to him you shall LISTEN – ¹⁶ just as you desired of the Lord your God at Horeb on the day of the assembly, when you said, 'Let me not hear again the voice of the Lord my God or see this great fire any more, lest I die.' ¹⁷ And the Lord said to me, 'They are right in what they have spoken. ¹⁸ I will raise up for them a prophet like you from among their brothers. And I will put my words in his mouth, and he shall speak to them all that I command him (Yehoshua/Joshua or Yeshua, both meaning,). ¹⁹ And whoever will not LISTEN to my words that he shall speak in my name, I myself will require it of him. ²⁰ But the prophet who presumes to speak a word in my name that I have not commanded him to speak, or who speaks in the name of other gods, that same prophet shall die.' ²¹ And if you say in your heart, 'How may we know the word that the Lord has not spoken?'— ²² when a prophet speaks in the name of the Lord, if the word does not come to pass or come true, that is a word that the Lord has not spoken; the prophet has spoken it presumptuously. You need not be afraid of him.

The English "Jesus" is a calque of the Greek Τησοῦς, or Iēsoûs. In translations of the Hebrew Bible into Ancient Greek, Iēsoûs was used to translate the Hebrew/Aramaic name Yeshua, a derivation of the earlier Hebrew Yehoshua, or Joshua. Both names mean "Yah saves". As a result, it is a commonly accepted fact within academia that Jesus' native Hebrew/Aramaic name was Yeshua.

Indeed, Yeshua is the Hebrew name for Jesus. It means "Yahweh [the Lord] is Salvation." The English spelling of Yeshua is "Joshua." However, when translated from Hebrew into Greek, in which the New Testament was written, the name Yeshua becomes Iēsous. The English spelling for Iēsous is "Jesus." This means Joshua and Jesus are the same names. One name is translated from Hebrew into English, the other from Greek into English. It is also interesting to note that the names "Joshua" and "Isaiah" are essentially the same names as Yeshua in Hebrew. They mean "savior" and "the salvation of the Lord."

Given how translation factors into this debate, must we call Jesus Yeshua? Think of it this way: Words for the same object are said differently across languages. While the dialect changes, the object itself does not. In the same way, we can refer to Jesus by different names without changing his nature. The names for him all mean 'the Lord is Salvation.'"

The Abomination of Desolation

15 "So when you see the abomination of desolation spoken of by the prophet Daniel, standing in the holy place (let the reader understand), 16 then let those who are in Judea flee to the mountains. ¹⁷ Let the one who is on the housetop not go down to take what is in his house, ¹⁸ and let the one who is in the field not turn back to take his cloak. ¹⁹ And alas for women who are pregnant and for those who are nursing infants in those days! ²⁰ Pray that your flight may not be in winter or on a Sabbath. 21 For then there will be great tribulation, such as has not been from the beginning of the world until now, no, and never will be. 22 And if those days had not been cut short, no human being would be saved. The Man of Lawlessness

Now concerning the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ and our being gathered together to him, we ask you, brothers, ² not to be quickly shaken in mind or alarmed, either by a spirit or a spoken word, or a letter seeming to be from us, to the effect that the day of the Lord has come. 3 Let no one deceive you in any way. For that day will not come, unless the rebellion comes first, and the man of lawlessness is revealed, the son of destruction, 4who opposes and exalts himself against every so-called god or object of worship, so that he takes his seat in the temple of God, proclaiming himself to be God.

Revelation 11:1-3

The Two Witnesses

"The King is in the Field"

2021 - Starts this Monday, August 9th (Elul 1) - Ends 40 days later, on the Feast of Atonement, Friday, September 17th at 6pm to Saturday, 18th at 6pm (Feast of Trumpets – Tuesday, September 7th at 6pm to Thursday, September 9th at 6pm)

Monday, August 9th at 6pm of next month begins "The King is in the Field", in which God's people search the Scriptures for the next 40 days to find the King, also known as the "Days of (God's) Favor", our Messiah, during the period of time when all Kings of Israel births where calculated from and Commissioned, and during this same season our Messiah will return, following several KEY Prophecies, as we will learn through this sermon series. Upon the completion of these next 8 weeks, we will be celebrating the "Feast of Trumpets" and the "Feast of Atonement", to tie these End Time teachings into God's Prophetic Biblical Calendar.

"My heart says of you, 'Seek His face!' Your face, Lord, I will seek." (Psalm 27:8)

Again, on the early morning of the 1st of Elul of the year 2448 from creation (1313 BCE) Moses ascended Mount Sinai, taking with him the stone tablets he had hewn by divine command, for G-d to re-inscribe the Ten Commandments. On the mountain, G-d allowed Moses to "see My back, but not My face" -- the closest any human being ever came to knowing G-d -- and taught him the secret of His "Thirteen Attributes of Mercy" (Exodus 33:18-34:8):

Moses remained on the mountain for 40 days, until the 10th of Tishrei (Yom Kippur), during which time He obtained G-d's whole-hearted forgiveness and reconciliation with the people of Israel following their betrayal of the covenant between them with their worship of the Golden Calf. This was the third of Moses' three 40-day periods on Mount Sinai in connection with the Giving of the Torah. Ever since, the month of Elul serves as the "month of Divine mercy and forgiveness."

We also find during this time, the reading of Isaiah 40:3-5:

"A voice cries: 'In the wilderness prepare the way of the LORD; make straight in the desert a highway for our God. Every valley shall be lifted up, and every mountain and hill be made low; the uneven ground shall become level, and the rough places a plain. And the glory of the LORD shall be revealed, and all flesh shall see it together, for the mouth of the LORD has spoken."

Isaiah 40:3-5

This prophecy of Isaiah would likely have been understood by the Israelites as an allusion to the ancient practice of eastern monarchs sending harbingers before them to prepare the way, leveling roads and removing impediments for the king.

Just as these monarchs prepared the way before themselves, God prepared the way before those who choose to follow Him, once slaves in to this world, leading them to their Promised Land. Like the Jewish exiles in Babylon, God He would prepare the way again for His Return and Future Reign, leading those, His people home, into the promise Land, the Kingdom of God. In which is also read during this time:

"Your procession, God, has come into view, the procession of my God and King into the sanctuary." (Psalm 68:24)

Although Elul is a month of repentance, it is also a time to contemplate God's mercy and forgiveness.

It is, in essence, a **period of renewal** – an opportunity to draw close to God.

Traditionally, this period is considered to be a time when God is accessible, when "the King is in the field."

As well, one must meticulously prepare for the meeting, including proper dress.

There are, however, times when the king leaves his palace and goes out into the field.

At this time, anyone can approach him, and all usual decorum and bureaucratic requirements are suspended.

During the month of Elul, it is said that God makes Himself accessible in this way.

Because of the King's presence, more time is spent in Torah study, in more fervent prayer, in greater generosity and giving. His presence has made the field a holier place. (Chabad)

This is the month in which we are, in a sense, welcomed back as being children of God; we are experiencing an *appointment* with the Lord of the Universe. To prepare for this, we need to examine ourselves closely. Still we have the certainty that God will forgive us, no matter what our sins might be.

These 40 days are a time of meeting with the King of Kings – a time to be happy.

⁴⁵ "Who then is the faithful and wise servant, whom his master has set over his household, to give them their food at the proper time? ⁴⁶ Blessed is that servant whom his master will find so doing when he comes. ⁴⁷ Truly, I say to you, he will set him over all his possessions. ⁴⁸ But if that wicked servant says to himself, 'My master is delayed,' ⁴⁹ and begins to beat his fellow servants and eats and drinks with drunkards, ⁵⁰ the master of that servant will come on a day when he does not expect him and at an hour he does not know (i.e. Luke 12:56, "You hypocrites! You know how to interpret the appearance of the earth and sky, but why do you not now how to interpret the present time?") ⁵¹ and will cut him in pieces and put him with the hypocrites. In that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

Why did Jesus give us these Prophecies? – to tell us, so that we might understand, that we are the people of the end times.

The end time has now arrived, a time Jesus spoke of nearly 2,000 years ago.

Overview of events occurring from here to the Battle of Armageddon

Before we review the Timeline, we must first acknowledge the Origin of the Timeline, the "Feasts of the Lord" created at the Foundations of the Earth on the 4th Day of Creation. The Spring Feasts are the Blue Print of the Fall Feasts, as Jesus fulfilled them one the Day and the Hour, and will do the same at His Second Coming.

1. Overview of events occurring from here to the Battle of Armageddon

- a. Sixth Trumpet War occurs when sixth trumpet of Revelation sounds
- b. Book of Revelation seven seals, seven trumpets, and seven vials

"The seals are the long story, the trumpets are the short story, and the vials are the real short story."

The book of Revelation is not in chronological order. The seals are the long story, the trumpets are the short story, and the vials are the real short story. They are three vantage points of the end time. You can view them in comparison with the synoptic gospels of Matthew, Mark, and Luke. We know this is true because the 6th and 7th seal, the 7th trumpet, and the 7th vial all record the same event, the second coming of Jesus Christ. Also if the kingdoms of this world become the kingdoms of our Lord and His Christ in Revelation 11:15, it would not make sense for the Antichrist to begin his rule in Revelation 13.

F. Israel's Third Temple

Daniel 11:31

And arms shall stand on his part, and they shall pollute the sanctuary of strength, and shall take away the daily sacrifice, and they shall place the abomination that maketh desolate.

G. War in Heaven

Revelation 12:7-8

And there was war in heaven: Michael and his angels, and prevailed not; neither was their place found any more in heaven.

1. Satan is banished from Heaven.

H. Satan Confined to the Earth – (the Great Tribulation is the Great Wrath of Satan)

Revelation 12:12-13

Therefore rejoice, ye heavens, and ye that dwell in them. But woe to the inhabiters of the earth and of the sea! For the DEVIL is come down unto you, HAVING GREAT WRATH, because he knows that he has but a short time. And when the dragon saw that he was cast unto the earth, he persecuted the woman (Israel) which brought forth the man child.

Q. Israel Makes its Last Stand at Jerusalem

C. Abomination of Desolation

Daniel 9:27

And he shall make a strong covenant with many for one week, and for half of the week he shall put an end to sacrifice and offering. And on the wing of abominations shall come one who makes desolate, until the decreed end is poured out on the desolator."

1. "He" is the Antichrist.

- a. He will confirm the Abrahamic Covenant.
- b. He will cause the sacrifices to Stop.
- c. He enacts the Abomination of Desolation.

2. Another prophecy of the Abomination of Desolation

a. Daniel 11:31 confirms that the Antichrist will Stop the daily sacrifices and place the Abomination of Desolation.

Daniel 11:31

Forces from him shall appear and profane the temple and fortress, and shall take away the regular burnt offering. And they shall set up the abomination that makes desolate.

God gave us a type of Abomination of Desolation, as a foreshadow of things to come, but not the Prophesied "Abomination of Desolation" of Daniel 9, Matthew 24, and Revelation 11-12 (where the prophecy teaches a period of time of 7 years, whereas the prophecy of Daniel 8 only speaks of a 6½ year period of time, 2/3 of a year short of the Daniel 9 Prophecy):

The prophecy of the 2,300 days ("evenings and mornings") is found in <u>Daniel 8:13–14</u>:

"Then I heard a holy one speaking, and another holy one said to him, 'How long will it take for the vision to be fulfilled—the vision concerning the daily sacrifice, the rebellion that causes desolation, the surrender of the sanctuary and the trampling underfoot of the Lord's people?' He said to me, 'It will take 2,300 evenings and mornings; then the sanctuary will be reconsecrated.'"

The time period covered, 2,300 days, figures to about 6 1/3 years. We believe this prophecy was fulfilled before the birth of Christ, during the reign of the Seleucid king Antiochus IV (Epiphanes). Antiochus desecrated the temple in Jerusalem and severely persecuted the Jews from about September 171 BC to December 165 BC. When Antiochus died, the Jews purified and rededicated the temple, just as Daniel had predicted. These events are commemorated in the celebration of Hanukkah.

The detailed prophecies contained in God's Word are part of what makes the Bible unique among religious texts. Our God can "make known the end from the beginning, from ancient times, what is still to come" (<u>Isaiah 46:10</u>), and He has revealed significant events in the future, counting out the very days of those periods of time.

Trans: Following is the account of the Events surrounding the "Abomination of Desolation" Type, foreshadowing the Daniel 9 Prophecy, but not to be confused with the fulfillment of the Daniel 8 Prophecy. Pay very close attention to the details of these events as to signs and types of the fulfillment of the Daniel 9 Prophecy.

Jewish Name and Meaning:

The Jewish name Hanukkah means <u>dedication</u>. The word in its various forms appears many times in the Old Testament portion of our Bible. It was used to describe the first use, the initiation, inauguration or dedication of a house, an altar or a priest. The word Hanukkah was used for the dedication of the Tabernacle in the wilderness by Moses, the dedication of the altar in Solomon's Temple, and the dedication of the Second Temple and wall around Jerusalem in the time of Ezra and Nehemiah. It is closely associated with consecration and anointing with oil. The verb form (Chanak) of the word also means to instruct or to <u>train up</u>. In Proverbs 22:6 it says, "<u>Train up</u> a child in the way he should go, when he is old he will not depart from it."

The Feast:

The feast itself commemorates the re-dedication of the Temple and its altar to God in the year 164 BCE (BCE means "Before Common Era" and is used by Jewish people like we use BC or "Before Christ"). Hanukkah is not described in the Old Testament portion of our Bibles because that portion ended with the prophet Malachi in 398 BCE. However, there are an additional fourteen books called the Old Testament Apocrypha. These books were written during the "400" silent years between Malachi and the birth of Jesus Christ. Although the Apocrypha is not included in the canon of Scripture it can be found in the "Catholic Bible". The historical account of Hanukkah is found in the book, 1 Maccabees 4:36-61.

Hanukkah, the Feast of Dedication starts on the 25th of Kislev and lasts for <u>eight</u> days. That date varies according to our calendar from November 27th to December 27th. Hanukkah is also known as the <u>Feast of Light</u>, as God miraculously provided enough oil to keep the lamps on the seven-branched golden lampstand burning for the entire eight days of the feast.

During the <u>eight</u>-day feast period of Hanukkah, Jewish people <u>read the book of Numbers chapters seven through eight</u> in their synagogues. Chapter seven tells of Moses and the leaders of Israel anointing and consecrating the Tabernacle, its altars, and furnishings. Chapter eight deals with setting up the seven-branched golden lampstand and setting the Levites apart for sacred service.

The Story Behind The Feast:

During the reign of Alexander, the Great (356 – 323 BCE) the Greeks conquered the known Biblical world (The "known Biblical world" is the area around the Mediterranean Sea. It stretched from India to France.). The Grecian period of influence lasted until 44 BCE when it was replaced by the Roman Empire. During their period of rule the Greeks forced their society, which was called Hellenism, upon the conquered people. It included their language, philosophy, religion, culture and governmental structure. The **goal** of Hellenism was a <u>one-world order</u>.

After Alexander the Great died, the Grecian empire was divided between his four generals: Cassander ruled in Macedon and Greece, Lysimachus in Asia Minor and Thrace, Ptolemy in Egypt and Seleucus in Mesopotamia and Persia. These four generals are referred to in the book of Daniel 8:8 and 11:4 (The Kingdom of Greece as a world power is described in Daniel chapters eight and eleven.).

One on Seleucus' descendents, Antiochus IV, ruled the Seleucid Empire (The territory included the northern and eastern portions of the Grecian Empire.) from 175 – 163 BCE. As king, he was very high on himself and even took the title "Epiphanes" which means "God Manifest." Antiochus, the villain in the story of the feast of Hanukkah, is the "little horn" or "despicable person" spoken of in Daniel 8:9 and 11:21. He is a "type" of the Antichrist who is to come and his story and character become intermingled with the Antichrist's in Daniel 8:9-12, 23-25, and 11:21-45. Similar events will occur at the time of Antichrist and the Great Tribulation.

Antiochus IV was the "supreme" Hellenizer and forced his one-world societal views on all of his subjects. The Hellenization of the Jews began in 173 BCE when Antiochus conspired with the Jewish High Priest at the time whose name was Jesus. This Jesus changed his name to Jason, a Greek name. Then in 169 BCE, Antiochus despoiled the Temple by taking its golden altar, lampstand, table of showbread, and the gold in the treasury to finance his campaigns.

Serious Hellenistic reform took place 167 BCE when a decree was issued for everyone in the empire to become one people by abandoning their own laws and religion. The Jews were forbidden from attending services in the Temple, participating in Sabbath and feast days, reading or possessing the Scriptures and circumcising their children. The penalty for failure to obey these laws was death!

On the 15th of Kislev in 167 BCE, Antiochus set up the "<u>abomination of desolation</u>" in the temple and built an altar on top of the existing altar of burnt offerings. No one knows for sure what this abomination was but many scholars have concluded that it was probably a statue of Zeus with Antiochus' face on it. Antiochus' desecration of the Temple was only a "type" of the "Abomination of Desolation" that is to come spoken of by Jesus Christ in His Olivet Discourse.

On the 25th of Kislev Antiochus sacrificed a pig on the altar and dedicated the temple to Zeus.

During this time a woman named Hannah and her seven sons were martyred for their faith. Each of the seven sons was asked in turn to bow to an idol or eat pork. Each son refused the request, professed his faith in God, and then was murdered. Upon refusal of the seventh son, both he and his mother were murdered.

A short time later, one of Antiochus' representatives entered the town of Modin to enforce the decree upon its people. He commanded one of the Jews to make a sacrifice to a foreign God. Then a priest named Mattathias Maccabees stepped forward and killed both of them thereby initiating a revolt. He led the revolt until his death later that year. Then, Judas Maccabees (The family name, Maccabees means "hammerer".), one of Matthias' five sons, took command of the resistance.

In a two-year span Judas won four major battles against superior Syrian forces and took control of Jerusalem in 164 BCE. He refurnished the temple with its furniture and utensils. Then he tore down the stones that covered the Lord's altar and had them buried. On the 25th of Kislev in 164 BCE, Judas rededicated the temple to God, exactly three years after Antiochus dedicated it to Zeus. He ordered a feast for the occasion, which lasted eight days and became known as Hanukkah.

When the temple was rededicated on the 25^{th} of Kislev, the lamps on the seven-branched golden lampstand were lit providing the only light in the temple. However, when the lamps were lit only one jar of sacred olive oil could be found that was not polluted because the seal of the high priest on it had not been broken. A jar of oil was only enough to keep the lamps burning for one day. Yet the lamps miraculously stayed burning for the entire eight days of the feast until more oil could be prepared and dedicated. That is why Hanukkah is also called the Feast of Light.

An interesting sidebar to this story is that Judas Maccabees was killed in a battle in 160 BCE and his brother assumed the leadership of Israel until 142 BCE. From the Maccabees came the Hasmonean line of rulers in Israel, who eventually became Hellenized themselves and oppressed their own people. King Herod the Great defeated them in 37 BCE and established his own line of rulers.

a. The Abomination of Desolation will take place in the holy place, which is in the temple on the Temple Mount.

So when you see the abomination of desolation spoken of by the prophet Daniel, standing in the holy place (let the reader understand).

4. What is the Abomination of Desolation?

- a. It is when the Antichrist sits in the temple of God claiming to be God.
- b. This is when he will be revealed.

The Seventy Weeks

²⁴ "Seventy weeks (or 490 years) are decreed about your people and your holy city, to finish the transgression, to put an end to sin, and to atone for iniquity, to bring in everlasting righteousness, to seal both vision and prophet, and to anoint a most holy place. ²⁵ Know therefore and understand that from the going out of the word to restore and build Jerusalem to the coming of an anointed one, a prince, there shall be seven weeks (or 49 years). Then for sixty-two weeks (or 483 years) it shall be built again with squares and moat, but in a troubled time. ²⁶ And after the sixty-two weeks, an anointed one shall be cut off and shall have nothing. And the people of the prince who is to come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary. Its end shall come with a flood, and to the end there shall be war. Desolations are decreed. ²⁷ And he shall make a strong covenant with many for one week (or 7 years), and for half of the week (or 3 ½ years) he shall put an end to sacrifice and offering. And on the wing of abominations shall come one who makes desolate, until the decreed end is poured out on the desolator."

Daniel Interprets the Dream

³¹ "You saw, O king, and behold, a great image. This image, mighty and of exceeding brightness, stood before you, and its appearance was frightening. ³² The head of this image was of fine gold (), its chest and arms of silver, its middle and thighs of bronze, ³³ its legs of iron, its feet partly of iron and partly of clay. ³⁴ As you looked, a stone was cut out by no human hand, and it struck the image on its feet of iron and clay, and broke them in pieces. ³⁵ Then the iron, the clay, the bronze, the silver, and the gold, all together were broken in pieces, and became like the chaff of the summer threshing floors; and the wind carried them away, so that not a trace of them could be found. The Gap

- 1. After the first 483 years was ended by the cutting off of the Messiah and before the events of the final seven-year period are described, there is a gap.
- 2. The fact there are gaps in this prophecy is the reason the prophecy is given in segments of 49 years, 434 years and seven years.
- 3. One more seven-year period of the prophecy is remaining.
- 4. How long does the gap last? It has lasted around 2,000 years.

The Final Seven Years

- 1. What we know is the Final Seven Years has still not begun.
- 2. The prophecy that tells us what will trigger the Final Seven Years is found in Daniel 9:27.

 Daniel 9:27

The Seventy Weeks

²⁷ And he shall make a strong covenant with many for one week (or 7 years), and for half of the week (or 3 ½ years) he shall put an end to sacrifice and offering. And on the wing of abominations shall come one who makes desolate, until the decreed end is poured out on the desolator."

To understand the verse, we must know five things:

- a. Who is "he"?
- b. What is "the covenant"?
- c. How long is "one week"?
- d. What "sacrifice" will be stopped and who stops them?
- e. What is the "Abomination of Desolation"?

1. Who is "he"?

- a. The prince that shall come.
- b. The "he" that is going to confirm the covenant is the Antichrist!

Daniel 11:31

And arms shall stand on his part, and they shall pollute the sanctuary of strength, and shall take away the daily sacrifice, and they shall place the abomination that maketh desolate.

- 1 Week Prophecy = 7 years of the total 490-year Prophecy (a time which includes the "half of the week" or 3 ½ years which will include the ending of sacrifices and offering, and leaving the remaining 3 ½ years of the 7 year prophecy to "the wing of abominations shall come one who makes desolate" and "the decreed end is poured out on the desolator" concluding the 70 total Prophesied Weeks "to finish the transgression, to put an end to sin, and to atone for iniquity, to bring in everlasting righteousness, to seal both vision and prophecy, and to anoint a most holy place" The Beginning of the 1,000 year Messianic Age on Earth)
 - 2020-2021 (5781 Biblical Calendar Date) Present Day (the possible beginning of the Final Week Prophecy "he shall make a strong covenant with many for one week" "The Abrahamic Accords")
 - The original <u>Abraham Accords</u> were signed by the UAE's Foreign Minister Abdullah bin Zayed Al Nahyan, Bahrain's Foreign Minister Abdullatif bin Rashid Al Zayani, Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu, and U.S. President Donald Trump on September 15, 2020, at the South Lawn of the White House in Washington, D.C.
 - The Feast of Trumpets was September 19 in 2020 (7-years from the signing of this Covenant, "Abrahamic Covenant", will be the coming of the Messiah on the Feast of Trumpets; which if it was not 2020, then it will have to be signed on or around this same Feast Period, "The Feast of Trumpets" as Prophecied).

Daniel 9:26-27

The Seventy Weeks

²⁶ And after the sixty-two weeks, an anointed one shall be cut off and shall have nothing. And the people of the prince who is to come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary. Its end shall come with a flood, and to the end there shall be war. Desolations are decreed. ²⁷ "And he shall make a strong covenant with many for one week, and for half of the week he shall put an end to sacrifice and offering. And on the wing of abominations shall come one who makes desolate, until the decreed end is poured out on the desolator."

The pronoun "he" in verse 27 agrees with the nearest antecedent, "the ruler who will come" (the Roman prince) of verse 26b, not the Anointed One of verse 26a...

Other texts indicate that the abominations of Daniel 9:27 (which include the abomination of desolation) are eschatological and perpetrated by Antichrist (Dan. 12:11; Matt. 24:15). The description of the person in Daniel 9:27 parallels that of the evil ruler who persecutes the saints in the book of Daniel and elsewhere in Scripture (cf. Dan. 7:25; 11:36-12:1; 2 Thess. 2:1-12; Rev. 13:1-10). This ruler is yet to come for he will be judged at Christ's return (cf. Dan. 7:11, 26; 11:45; 2 Thess. 2:8; Rev. 19:20. "The end that is decreed is poured out on him" is specifically described in Daniel 7:11, 26; and 11:45-12:1. Accordingly, the person who makes the covenant and persecutes the saints is the eschatological Antichrist. He will continue his tyranny until Christ returns and judges him.

The Day of the Lord

Now concerning the times and the seasons, brothers, you have no need to have anything written to you.

<u>times</u>: (chronos – 5550 Strong's) – exact time (plural joined with kairós).

5550 *xrónos* – *time* (in general), especially viewed *in sequence* (a "*succession* of moments"); *time* in *duration* in the *physical-space world*, sovereignly apportioned by God to each person; especially expresses time *quantitatively* (with regard to the quantity of something rather than its quality)

seasons/epochs: (*kairós* – 2540 Strong's) – a fixed and definite time, appointed times, an occasion, set or proper time, for a certain time only, for the season of an hour, i.e. for a short season.

2540 *kairós – time* as *opportunity*. 2540 /*kairós* ("opportune time") is derived from *kara* ("head") referring to things "coming to a head" to take full-advantage of. 2540 (*kairós*) is "the *suitable* time, the *right moment* (e.g. Soph., *El*. 1292), a *favorable moment*" (*DNTT*, 3, 833).

times: (zeman – 2166 Strong's) – festival seasons (festival), appointed periods, epochs law: (dath – 1882 Strong's) – absolute law, law(s) of God.

9. Ten toes of iron mingled with clay

Daniel 2:44

And in the days of those kings the God of heaven will set up a kingdom that shall never be destroyed, nor shall the kingdom be left to another people. It shall break in pieces all these kingdoms and bring them to an end, and it shall stand forever.

- a. This is the same ten kings prophesied in Daniel 7.
- b. The Antichrist will come up among these ten kings.
- c. The Antichrist will come out of the reborn Holy Roman Empire, which is the European Union.
